KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE HARDIN COUNTY COMMON PLEAS COURT

Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Scott N. Barrett of Kenton (Hardin Co.) to serve as a judge on the Hardin County Common Pleas Court, General and Domestic Relations Division. Barrett will assume office on March 25, 2013, and must run in November 2014 in order to retain the seat for the unexpired term, which ends December 31, 2016. Barrett is replacing William Hart, who retired.

Barrett received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Ohio Northern University and earned his juris doctorate from the Ohio Northern University Claude W. Pettit College of Law. Since 1988, he has been self-employed at Roof & Barrett Attorneys at Law.

Barrett was appointed by the mayor in 1977 to be on the Kenton City Planning Commission. He also received the Award of Merit from the Ohio Legal Center Institute where he briefly lectured.
