TEN COMPANIES EXPECTED TO INVEST \$8.7 MILLION, IMPACTING MORE THAN 1,000 JOBS

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the approval of assistance for 10 projects set to create 349 jobs and retain 708 jobs statewide. During its monthly meeting, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (TCA) reviewed economic development proposals brought to the board by JobsOhio and its regional partners. Collectively, the projects are expected to result in \$17.4 million in new payroll, and spur nearly \$8.7 million in investment across Ohio.

Projects approved by the TCA include:

CENTRAL

PEOPLETOMYSITE.com, LLC, City of Columbus (Franklin Co.) expects to create 50 full-time positions, generating \$2.8 in additional annual payroll and retaining \$1.9 in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the City of Columbus (Franklin Co.). PEOPLETOMYSITE.com is an internet marketing provider. The TCA approved a 45 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

The Liberty Technology Company, LLC and Liberty Casting Company LLC, City of Delaware (Delaware Co.) expects to create 52 full-time positions, generating \$2 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$6.5 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's consolidation project in the City of Delaware (Delaware Co.). Liberty Technology is a jobbing foundry that specializes in the manufacturing of numerous castings. The TCA approved a 45 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

NORTHEAST

Aurora Plastics, Inc., City of Streetsboro (Portage Co.) expects to create 19 full-time positions, generating \$1.5 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$3.4 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the City of Streetsboro (Portage Co.). Aurora Plastics produces PVC compounds for the window, fencing, siding, decking and pipe markets. The TCA approved a 40 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

Selman & Company, LLC, City of Cleveland (Cuyahoga Co.) expects to create 40 full-time positions, generating \$1.7 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$4.95 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the City of Cleveland (Cuyahoga Co.). Selman & Company markets and administers insurance products to associations and affinity groups nationwide. The TCA approved a 40 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

NORTHWEST

IntelliHARTx, LLC, City of Findlay (Hancock Co.) expects to create 50 full-time positions, generating \$1.7 million in additional annual payroll as a result of the company's new location project in the City of Findlay (Hancock Co.). IntelliHARTx is a healthcare service business providing collection and recovery of patient self-pay and bad debt balances for hospitals and large physician groups. The TCA approved a 45 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

SOUTHWEST

Coupons.com, Incorporated, Deerfield Township (Warren Co.) expects to create 22 full-time positions, generating \$1.5 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$3.4 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in Deerfield Township (Warren Co.). Coupons.com is a website of digital coupons. The TCA approved a 40 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

McFeely's, Inc., City of Harrison (Hamilton Co.) expects to create 14 full-time positions, generating \$670,000 in additional annual payroll as a result of the company's acquisition project in the City of Harrison (Hamilton Co.). McFeely's is a supplier of fasteners and woodworking tools. The TCA approved a 35 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

Zipscene, LLC, City of Cincinnati (Hamilton Co.) expects to create 47 full-time positions, generating \$3.8 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$1.8 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the City of Cincinnati (Hamilton Co.). Zipscene is a technology company that helps companies target their marketing campaigns to specific customers and customer groups. The TCA approved a 45 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

NORTHERN

Venture Packaging, Village of Monroeville (Huron Co.) expects to create 45 full-time positions, generating \$1.1 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$12.8 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the Village of Monroeville (Huron Co.). Venture packaging manufactures and markets plastic consumer packaging and engineered materials. The TCA approved a 40 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

SOUTHEASTERN

Miba Energy Holding LLC, Village of McConnelsville (Morgan Co.) expects to create 10 full-time positions, generating \$705,000 in additional annual payroll as a result of the company's new location project in the Village of McConnelsville (Morgan Co.). Miba produces engine components. The TCA approved a 40 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.
