**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE HAMILTON COUNTY COURT OF
COMMON PLEAS**

Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Carl J. Stich, Jr. of Mariemont (Hamilton Co.) to serve as a judge on the Hamilton County Court of Common Pleas. Stich will assume office April 12, 2013, and must run in November 2014 in order to retain the seat for the full term, which commences on January 4, 2015. Stich is replacing R. Patrick DeWine, who was elected to the First District Court of Appeals.

Stich received a Bachelor of Science in Accountancy from the University of Kentucky, and earned his juris doctorate from the University of Kentucky College of Law. From 2001 to 2003, and again from 2005 to now, he has worked as an attorney for White, Getgey & Meyer Co. L.P.A..

Stich is a member of the Mariemont Planning Commission, a chairman for the Cincinnati Bar Association's Ethics Committee, and has previously served on the board of United Cerebral Palsy of Cincinnati. Since 2003, he has taught trial practice at the University of Cincinnati College of Law. In addition, Stich has been acknowledged by his peers through inclusion in the *Best Lawyers in America* publication.
