KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO WARREN COUNTY COURT

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Robert S. Fischer of Maineville (Warren Co.) to serve as a judge on the Warren County Court. Fischer will assume office on April 4, 2014, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the remainder of the unexpired term, which ends December 31, 2018. Fischer is replacing Judge Joseph Kirby, who was appointed to Warren County Common Pleas Court, Probate and Juvenile Division.

Fischer received a Bachelor of Science degree from Frostburg State University and earned his juris doctorate from Emory University School of Law. Since 1999, he has served as a trial attorney at Sams, Fischer, Packard & Schuessler, LLC.

Fischer previously served as trial attorney for Kirby & Roberts, LLC in LaGrange, Georgia and as assistant prosecutor in the Mason Municipal Court. He was named one of Cincy Magazine's "Leading Lawyers" in the field of criminal law in 2011, 2012 and 2013. An active member of the community, Fischer has served in a number of roles including the board of directors for the Warren County Abuse and Rape Crisis Shelter, board member and president of the Kiwanis Club of Mason, president of the Union Centre Boulevard Merchants Association, and member of the West Chester Chamber Alliance Government Issues Committee.
