**KASICH AND TAYLOR ISSUE PROCLAMATION HONORING VIETNAM  
VETERANS DAY**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich and Lieutenant Governor Mary Taylor issued a proclamation in honor of Vietnam Veterans Day on Sunday, March 30, 2014, encouraging Ohioans to take a moment to thank Vietnam veterans for their service.
