**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE WAYNE COUNTY MUNICIPAL COURT**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Timothy R. VanSickle of Orrville (Wayne Co.) to serve as judge on the Wayne County Municipal Court. VanSickle will assume office on April 10, 2013, and must run in November 2013 to retain the seat for the unexpired term, which ends December 31, 2015. VanSickle is replacing Mark Clark, who retired.

VanSickle received a Bachelor of Science in Industrial Management from the University of Akron, and earned his juris doctorate from the University of Akron School of Law. Since July 2012, he has served as Wayne County Juvenile Court magistrate.

VanSickle is currently the vice president of the Wayne County Board of Health, and a member of the Orrville Christian Church, where he is an elder and a Sunday school teacher. VanSickle is also a past member of the Orrville/Dalton YMCA Board of Directors and the Orrville Rotary Club.
