**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO FAIRFIELD COUNTY  
MUNICIPAL COURT**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of James A. Fields of Lancaster (Fairfield Co.) to serve as a judge on the Fairfield County Municipal Court. Fields will assume office on April 30, 2015, and must run in November 2015 to retain the seat for the remainder of the unexpired term, which ends December 31, 2017. Fields is replacing Judge David A. Trimmer, who has been elected to the Fairfield County Court of Common Pleas, General Division.

Fields received his bachelor's degree from Earlham College and his juris doctorate from Capital University. His past experience includes work with the law firm of Gary Paul Price and as well as the law firm Fields & Innocenti.

He is currently a member of the Multi-County Juvenile Detention Center Board. He has served as the chair of the Fairfield County Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Services Board and as a board member of the Fairfield County Mental Health Consumer Group.
