**KASICH AND TAYLOR ISSUE PROCLAMATION IN HONOR OF DAYS
OF REMEMBRANCE**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich and Lieutenant Governor Mary Taylor issued a proclamation recognizing the week of April 27-May 4, 2014 as Days of Remembrance, a time dedicated to the memory of the victims of the Holocaust and in honor of the survivors, rescuers and liberators.

“We should always remember the terrible events of the Holocaust and remain vigilant against hatred, persecution and tyranny,” Kasich and Taylor shared in the resolution. “We should actively rededicate ourselves to the principles of individual freedom in a just society.”
