Hiring at Procter & Gamble's Union distribution center will likely begin in November, said a spokeswoman for the third-party logistics company operating the center.

Lynn Anderson, vice president of communications for Exel, said the the new 1-million-square-foot distribution center will be operational early next year. The company expects to work with the Montgomery County Jobs Center and others to find the best employees, and there may be job fairs, as well, she said.

Cincinnati-based Procter & Gamble Co. will create about 800 jobs at a new \$89 million distribution center to be built near Dayton.

The 1 million-square-foot center in the city of Union, which is expected to begin operating in 2015, will distribute household goods made by P&G to customers in the Midwest. The jobs will be created through third-party customization and logistics providers.

### **Auto glass plant finalized at former Ohio GM site**

DAYTON, Ohio (AP) -- A Chinese company has finalized its plan to build an automotive glass-making plant in southwest Ohio, creating about 800 jobs and revitalizing a former General Motors factory site.

Fuyao (FWEE'-ow) Glass Industry Group Co. paid \$15 million for 1.2 million square feet for the former auto plant and plans a \$230 million investment.

### **Fuyao finalizes deal for massive Dayton plant, 800 jobs**

Fuyao has officially purchased a large portion of the former GM plant in Moraine.

The news came via a surprise visit from Dewang Cao, chairman of the Chinese automotive glass maker.

Cao attended the I-70/75 Development Association's annual Economic Development Summit at Sinclair Community College.

He said he picked Ohio because he was impressed by the work of JobsOhio, the state's private development arm.

"I could see the pro-business environment, as well as the strong background in manufacturing," Cao said through an interpreter.
