**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE JACKSON COUNTY COMMON
PLEAS COURT**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Christopher J. Regan of Jackson (Jackson Co.) to serve as a judge on the Jackson County Common Pleas Court, General and Domestic Relations Divisions. Regan will assume office on July 1, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the remainder of the unexpired term, which ends December 31, 2016. Regan is replacing Leonard Holzapfel, who retired.

Regan received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Albright College in 1981, a Masters of Arts from Villanova University in 1982, and earned his juris doctorate from Capital University in 1986. Since 2000, he has served as magistrate of the Jackson County Common Pleas Court, and has also served as magistrate of the Jackson County Municipal Court since 2008.
