**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE STARK COUNTY COURT OF
COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of J. Curtis Werren of Canton (Stark Co.) to serve as a judge on the Stark County Court of Common Pleas, General Division. Werren will assume office on July 8, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the remainder of the unexpired term, which ends January 1, 2017. Werren is replacing Lee Sinclair, who retired.

Werren received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Grove City College in 1989, and earned his juris doctorate from The Ohio State University in 1992. Since 2010, he has served as the executive director of the American Red Cross – Stark County Chapter.

Werren has been involved in the Stark County Rotary Club, the Stark County Safety Council Steering Committee and the Stark County Mental Health and Recovery Services Board. He was also a partner at the Day, Ketterer, Ltd., Attorneys at Law from 1992 to 2010.
