**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE CLINTON COUNTY  
MUNICIPAL COURT**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Michael T. Daugherty of Wilmington (Clinton Co.) to serve as a judge on the Clinton County Municipal Court. Daugherty will assume office on July 7, 2015, and must run in November 2015 to retain the seat for the full term commencing January 1, 2016. Daugherty is replacing Judge Chad L. Carey, who has been elected to the Clinton County Probate and Juvenile Court.

Daugherty received his undergraduate degree from Wilmington College and his juris doctorate from the University of Dayton. His experience includes service as President of the Clinton County Bar Association and Treasurer of the Fayette County Bar Association. In addition, he has served on numerous advisory boards in Clinton and surrounding counties.
