**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE FRANKLIN COUNTY  
COURT OF COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Rita McNeil Danish of Gahanna (Franklin Co.) to serve as a judge on the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, Domestic Relations and Juvenile Divisions. McNeil Danish will assume office on July 14, 2014, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the remainder of the unexpired term, which ends January 1, 2019. McNeil Danish is replacing Judge Jim Mason, who retired.

McNeil Danish received her Bachelor of Business Administration from Howard University, and received her juris doctorate from The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law. McNeil Danish is the founder and CEO of JD<sup>2</sup> Strategists, LLC in Dayton, Ohio. She also serves as counsel for Crabbe, Brown & James in Columbus.
