Miba Sinter to bring 100 new jobs to area

MCCONNELLSVILLE — During its four years of local production, Miba Sinter USA has been met with so much success, it has doubled the size of its production facility, and expects to create 100 high-paying jobs within the next three years.

Miba Sinter, a faction of the Austrian-based Miba Group, produces high-precision automobile parts used in transmission, steering and other systems for the majority of large production companies including BMW, Audi, Volvo and GM. The McConnellsville plant began production in 2010, moving into a facility next to the Miba Bearings USA plant built in 2001.

Ohio Gov. John Kasich said the \$8 million expansion of the facility, in combination with the \$51 million Miba already has invested in McConnellsville, shows the promise of a brighter future for Morgan County.
