**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY COURT OF
COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Terre L. Vandervoort of Lancaster (Fairfield Co.) to serve as a judge on the Fairfield County Court of Common Pleas Probate/Juvenile Division. Vandervoort will assume office on August 5, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the full term beginning February 9, 2015. Vandervoort is replacing Judge Steven O. Williams, who retired.

Vandervoort received a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from Miami University in Oxford, and earned his juris doctorate from The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law. Since 1996, she has served as law director and city prosecutor for Lancaster.

Throughout her career, Vandervoort has been committed to professional education and has completed various programs focusing on domestic violence, drug interdiction, and drunk driving among other things.
