KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE FRANKLIN COUNTY MUNICIPAL COURT

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Daniel R. Hawkins of Westerville (Franklin Co.) to serve as a judge on the Franklin County Municipal Court, Environmental Division. Hawkins will assume office on July 29, 2013, and must run in November 2013 to retain the seat for the remainder of the unexpired term, which ends January 7, 2016. Hawkins is replacing Judge Harland H. Hale, who retired.

Hawkins received a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice, with a minor in Sociology, from Bowling Green State University, and earned his juris doctorate from The Ohio State University College of Law. Since 1999, he has served in the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office.

Hawkins has been involved with the Central Ohio Sexual Assault Task Force, and he is also a member of the Franklin County Violence Against Women Act Advisory Board and the Franklin County Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force.
