**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE MUSKINGUM COUNTY COURT OF  
COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Judge Eric D. Martin of Zanesville (Muskingum Co.) to serve as a judge on the Muskingum County Court of Common Pleas, Probate/Juvenile Division. Martin will assume office on August 13, 2014, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the full term commencing February 9, 2015. Martin is replacing Judge Joseph A. Gormley, who retired.

Martin received his Bachelor of Arts from Ohio University, and received his juris doctorate from the University of Akron School of Law. He is a partner at Allen, Baughman and Martin Law Offices.

Martin has previously served as Assistant Prosecuting Attorney for Muskingum County as well as Solicitor for Frazeytsburg and Magistrate for Frazeytsburg, Dresden, South Zanesville and Roseville.
