**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE LUCAS COUNTY COURT OF
COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Michael R. Goulding of Toledo (Lucas Co.) to serve as a judge on the Lucas County Court of Common Pleas. Goulding will assume office on August 26, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the unexpired term ending January 1, 2017. Goulding is replacing Judge James D. Jensen, who was elected to the Sixth District Court of Appeals.

Goulding received a Bachelor of Arts degree in English from The Ohio State University, and earned his juris doctorate from the University of Toledo College of Law. In 2007, he was appointed to serve as judge on the Toledo Municipal Court and was elected to a six year term later in the year.

Goulding is a member of the ABLE/LAWO Emerging Leaders Council and co-founded the Northwest Ohio Municipal/County Judges' Association—of which he was elected president in 2012. He and his wife, Amy, have three children, Abby, Madeline and Peter.
