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NINE COMPANIES EXPECTED TO INVEST \$1.1 BILLION, IMPACTING 1,787 JOBS

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the approval of assistance for nine projects set to create 586 jobs and retain 1,201 jobs statewide. During its monthly meeting, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (TCA) reviewed economic development proposals brought to the board by JobsOhio and its regional partners. Collectively, the projects are expected to result in \$30,659,048 in new payroll, and spur more than \$1.1 billion in investment across Ohio.

Projects approved by the TCA include:

CENTRAL

Eloquii Design, Inc., City of Columbus (Franklin Co.) expects to create 40 full-time positions, generating \$4.5 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$740,200 in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the City of Columbus (Franklin Co.). Eloquii Design sells and designs fashion apparel. The TCA approved a 50 percent, seven-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

WESTERN

Dole Fresh Vegetables, Inc., City of Springfield (Clark Co.) expects to create 138 full-time positions, generating \$3.2 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$17.5 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the City of Springfield (Clark Co.). Dole markets and sells frozen and packaged fruits and vegetables worldwide. The TCA approved a 50 percent, nine-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

SOUTHWEST

Faurecia Emissions Control Systems NA, LLC, City of Franklin (Warren Co.) expects to create 120 full-time positions, generating \$4.5 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$15.4 in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the City of Franklin (Warren Co.). Faurecia Emissions Control Systems manufactures automobile exhaust systems. The TCA approved a 55 percent, eight-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

NORTHEAST

Fosbel, Inc., City of Brook Park (Cuyahoga Co.) expects to create 14 full-time positions, generating \$934,816 in additional annual payroll and retaining \$3.2 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the City of Brook Park (Cuyahoga Co.). Fosbel provides take-out and on-site furnace refractory maintenance services, including engineering and repair. The TCA approved a 35 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

GOJO Industries, Inc., City of Brecksville (Cuyahoga Co.) expects to create 37 full-time positions, generating \$1.7 million in additional annual payroll as a result of the company's new location project in the City of Brecksville (Cuyahoga Co.). GOJO produces and markets skin health and hygiene solutions for away-from-home settings. The TCA approved a 40 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

NORTHWEST

Standard Technologies, LLC, City of Fremont (Sandusky Co.) expects to create 39 full-time positions, generating \$1.8 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$2.2 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's new location project in the City of Fremont (Sandusky Co.). Standard Technologies produces industrial battery trays, mine battery trays, fuel tanks and systems, hydraulic reservoirs and other customized products. The TCA approved a 30 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

LOCATION TBD

Stolle Machinery Company, LLC (Location TBD) expects to create 42 full-time positions, generating \$2.1 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$6.1 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project at a to-be-determined location. Stolle Machinery provides metal packaging solutions. The TCA approved a 45 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

Vadata, Inc. (Location TBD) expects to create 120 full-time positions, generating \$9.6 million in additional annual payroll as a result of the company's new project at a to-be-determined location, if Ohio is ultimately chosen for the project. Vadata offers global computing, storage, database, analytics, application and deployment services that help organizations move faster, lower IT costs and scale applications. The TCA approved a 75 percent, 15-year Job Creation Tax Credit and a 100 percent, 15-year data center sales tax exemption for this project.

BioRx, LLC (Location TBD) expects to create 36 full-time positions, generating \$2.4 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$6.1 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project at a to-be-determined location. BioRx is specialty pharmacy provider. The TCA approved a 50 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

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
