NEW PROJECTS SET TO CREATE 591 JOBS

COLUMBUS – Gov. John R. Kasich today announced the approval of assistance for nine projects set to create more than 591 jobs and retain 943 jobs statewide. During the Ohio Tax Credit Authority's (TCA) monthly meeting, it reviewed economic development proposals brought to the board by JobsOhio and its regional partners. Together the projects are expected to result in more than \$29 million in new payroll and \$40 million in investment across Ohio.

Projects approved by the TCA include:

NORTHEAST OHIO

Myers Industries, Inc., Village of Middlefield (Geauga Co.) expects to create 65 full-time positions, generating \$2 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$11 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the Village of Middlefield (Geauga Co.). Myers Industries is a brand of plastic pots, trays, baskets and decorative resin planters for the professional grower industry and retail garden centers. The TCA approved a 40 percent, seven-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

Royal Appliance Manufacturing Company. dba TTI Floor Care North America, Village of Glenwillow (Cuyahoga Co.) expects to create 212 full-time positions, generating \$12.4 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$20 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the Village of Glenwillow (Cuyahoga Co.). TTI has combined Hoover with its existing Dirt Devil and Royal Appliance operations in Glenwillow to create TTI Floor Care North America, the largest floor care business in North America. The TCA approved a 60 percent, seven-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

SOUTHWEST OHIO

Benjamin Steel Company, Inc., City of Cincinnati (Hamilton Co.) expects to create 40 full-time positions, generating \$1.5 million in additional annual payroll as a result of the company's new location project in the City of Cincinnati (Hamilton Co.). Benjamin Steel Company offers product, processing and specialty solutions for steel products and services. The TCA approved a 40 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

Contingent Network Services LLC, West Chester Twp. (Butler Co.) expects to create 75 full-time positions, generating \$3.4 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$7.8 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in West Chester Twp. (Butler Co.). Contingent Network Services is a global technology services company specializing in managing secure wide area networks, integration, logistics and maintenance for large enterprises. The TCA approved a 45 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

Healthcare Regional Marketing LLC, Union Twp. (Clermont Co.) expects to create 30 full-time positions, generating \$1.3 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$1.6 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in Union Twp. (Clermont Co.). Healthcare Regional Marketing is a healthcare marketing and deployment organization that specializes in pharmaceutical regional market solutions. The TCA approved a 40 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

Pioneer Cladding and Glazing Systems, LLC, City of Mason (Warren Co.) expects to create 50 full-time positions, generating \$3.3 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$3.7 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's relocation project in the City of Mason (Warren Co.). Pioneer Cladding and Glazing Systems helps in the development of buildings from pre-construction to installation. The TCA approved a 45 percent, seven-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

WESTERN OHIO

Casad Company, Inc., City of Celina (Mercer Co.) expects to create 59 full-time positions, generating \$1.4 million in additional annual payroll and retaining \$1.5 million in existing payroll as a result of the company's expansion project in the City of Celina (Mercer Co.). Casad Company prints invitations, brochures, banners, posters, calendars and signs. The TCA approved a 40 percent, six-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

Independent Can Company, City of Vandalia (Montgomery Co.) expects to create 30 full-time positions, generating \$1.4 million in additional annual payroll as a result of the company new location project in the City of Vandalia (Montgomery Co.). Independent Can Company develops, designs and manufactures tinplate packaging and flat sheet metal decorating products. The TCA approved a 45 percent, seven-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.

Intelligent Decisions, Inc., City of Dayton (Montgomery Co.) expects to create 30 full-time positions, generating \$2.4 million in additional annual payroll as a result of the company's new location project in the City of Dayton (Montgomery Co.). Intelligent Decisions provides solutions related to computer network defense, information assurance, data encryption and authentication. The TCA approved a 45 percent, five-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this project.
