KASICH ORDERS FLAGS FLOWN AT HALF-STAFF TO COMMEMORATE 9/11

COLUMBUS—Today Governor John R. Kasich ordered flags to be flown at half-staff upon all public buildings and grounds throughout Ohio in honor of the lives lost in the attacks that occurred on September 11, 2001. Flags will be flown at half-staff from sunrise to sunset on September 11, 2013.

Additionally, the governor issued a resolution in honor of Patriot Day and the National Day of Service and Remembrance in which he says: “We honor and pay tribute to our courageous men and women in uniform serving around the world, as well as to the dedicated members of our law enforcement, public safety, and intelligence communities who work diligently to protect us from danger and when called upon, stand willing to pay the ultimate sacrifice to preserve the freedoms we hold dear.” A copy of the governor’s resolution can be viewed [here](#).
