**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE TOLEDO MUNICIPAL COURT**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Joshua W. Lanzinger of Toledo (Lucas Co.) to serve as a judge on the Toledo Municipal Court. Lanzinger will assume office on September 16, 2013, and must run in November 2013 to retain the seat for the full term commencing January 1, 2014. Lanzinger is replacing Judge Michael R. Goulding, who was appointed to the Lucas County Court of Common Pleas.

Lanzinger received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Philosophy from University of Dayton, and earned his juris doctorate from the University of Toledo College of Law. Since 2004, he has served as the Assistant Attorney General for the Ohio Attorney General's Office.

Lanzinger began his law career as an associate for Anspach, Meeks, Ellenberger, L.L.P. in 1998, and served as a member of the United States Army from 2002 to 2004. He is also involved in various community and professional organizations in the Toledo area.
