KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE LAKE COUNTY PROBATE COURT

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Mark J. Bartolotta of Concord (Lake Co.) to serve as a judge on the Lake County Probate Court. Bartolotta will assume office on September 23, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the full term commencing February 9, 2015. Bartolotta is replacing Judge Ted Klammer, who passed away.

Bartolotta received a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from the University of Akron, and earned his juris doctorate from the Cleveland Marshall College of Law. Since February of this year, he has served as the chief assistant prosecutor for the Geauga County Prosecutor's Office.

Bartolotta has taught courses at Lake Erie College and Lakeland Community College, and served in the Lake County Prosecutor's Office from 1992 to 2013.
