**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO LOGAN COUNTY COURT OF
COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Dan W. Bratka of West Liberty (Logan Co.) to serve as Judge of the Logan County Court of Common Pleas. Bratka will assume office on September 15, 2012, and must run in November 2012 in order to retain the seat for the unexpired term which ends January 1, 2017.

Bratka received a Bachelor of Science degree in social science from Urbana University and earned his juris doctorate from the Ohio Northern University College of Law. Since 2005, he has served as the magistrate of the Domestic Relations, Juvenile, and Probate Courts of Logan County.

Bratka is currently the Vice President of the Logan County Historical Society, and is retired from the United States Air Force Reserves with 35 years of service. Bratka is also a life member of the American Legion, Air Force Association, and Reserve Officer's Association.
