KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE 12TH DISTRICT COURT OF APPEALS

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Michael E. Powell of Lebanon (Warren Co.) to serve as Judge of the 12th District Court of Appeals. Powell will assume office on October 4, 2012, and must run in November 2012 in order to retain the seat for the unexpired term which ends February 9, 2017.

Powell received a Bachelor of Arts degree in political science from Ohio Northern University and earned his juris doctorate from the Ohio Northern University College of Law. Since 2000, he has served as the judge of Probate and Juvenile Courts of Warren County.

Powell is currently the Vice Chairman of the Warren County Salvation Army Advisory Board, and is a past president of the Lebanon Kiwanis. Powell is also an inductee of the Lebanon City Schools Hall of Fame.
