**KASICH ORDERS FLAGS FLOWN AT HALF-STAFF IN HONOR OF ARMY  
SPECIALIST JOSEPH RILEY**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich ordered that all flags on public buildings and grounds throughout Franklin County be flown at half-staff from sunrise to sunset on December 6, 2014, in honor of Army Specialist Joseph "Joey" Riley. His order reads:

“In honor of the life and service of Army Specialist Joseph "Joey" Riley, I hereby proclaim, by the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Ohio by the Ohio Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, that the flags of the United States of America and the State of Ohio shall be flown at half-staff upon all public buildings and grounds throughout Franklin County from sunrise to sunset on December 6, 2014.”
