### **Executive Order 2011-15K**

The Emergency Amendment of Rule 5101:3-27-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code  
by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.

**WHEREAS**, implementation of a reimbursement rate revision for the community psychiatric supportive treatment service is a component of my Administration's strategy to balance the state budget.

**WHEREAS**, with the passage of Am. Sub. H.B. No. 153 by the 129<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, amendments to the Ohio Administrative Code implementing the reimbursement rate revision necessary to help assure a balanced state budget must be enacted with a July 1, 2011 effective date.

**WHEREAS**, Section 5111.02 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) to promulgate rules relating to the provision of Medicaid reimbursed mental health services administered by the Ohio Department of Mental Health.

**WHEREAS**, Section 119.03(F) of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Governor, upon the request of a state agency, to determine that an emergency exists necessitating the immediate adoption, amendment, or rescission of an agency rule.


**WHEREAS**, ODJFS has requested a determination whether an emergency exists that requires the immediate amendment of Rule 5101:3-27-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code in order for ODJFS, pursuant to Section 5111.02 of the Ohio Revised Code, to implement a tiered rate structure for the community psychiatric supportive treatment service.

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, John R. Kasich, Governor of the State of Ohio, have determined, upon the request of ODJFS, that an emergency exists requiring the immediate amendment of Rule 5101:3-27-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code by ODJFS. Further, I hereby order that the procedures prescribed by Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code with respect to the amendment of such specified rule be suspended and ODJFS be permitted to immediately amend this rule by electronically filing it with the Secretary of State, the Director of the Legislative Service Commission, and the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.

Further, I hereby order that this Executive Order be filed in electronic form with ODJFS, the Secretary of State, the Director of the Legislative Service Commission, and the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.

I signed this Executive Order on June 30, 2011 in Columbus, Ohio and it will expire at the end of the ninetieth day it is in effect.
