**Governor-elect Kasich Appoints Directors to Departments of
Commerce & Youth Services**

COLUMBUS – At a press conference in Columbus today Governor-elect John Kasich announced his appointments of David Goodman to be director of the Department of Commerce and Christine Money to be director of the Department of Youth Services.

David Goodman, Director of the Ohio Department of Commerce

Goodman has nearly 20 years of legal experience and has been a member of the General Assembly for 12 years. During his tenure in the Legislature, Goodman served on the House Finance and Financial Institutions Committee which worked closely with the Department of Commerce on the regulation of financial institutions. Additionally, Goodman was the primary sponsor of consumer protections legislation, as well as construction reform legislation.

Christine Money, Director of the Ohio Department of Youth Services

Money has served as the Interim Director of the Department of Youth Services since May 2010. Prior to assuming her current role she held various positions within the Department, including Deputy Director of the Department of Youth Services' Division of Facility Programs and Operations, Superintendent of the Scioto Juvenile Correctional Facility, and Special Assistant to the Director. Earlier in her career, Money served as warden of three different Ohio correctional facilities.
