**KASICH APPOINTS STATE REPRESENTATIVE TODD MCKENNEY TO SUMMIT  
COUNTY COMMON PLEAS COURT**

COLUMBUS - Today Gov. John R. Kasich appointed State Representative Todd McKenney of Manchester (Summit Co.) to serve as judge of the Summit County Common Pleas Court, Probate Division. He will assume office on November 18, 2011 and must run in November 2012 in order to serve out the remainder of the unexpired term ending February 8, 2015.

McKenney earned his bachelor's degree from Hiram College and his juris doctor from The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law. He has served as a member of the Ohio General Assembly and was an attorney at McKenney & Gingrich Co., LPA, focusing on estate planning, probate and trust administration. McKenney also has served as a City Council member in the city of New Franklin as well as the Mercy and Justice Pastor for The Chapel in Akron and Green. He is a member of the Ohio State Bar Association and the Akron Bar Association.
