RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, as Ohio competes in the global economy of the 21st Century, our citizens recognize the challenges ahead and accept the responsibility of providing their children with the education and skills that will enable them to compete successfully as individuals and as a state; and

WHEREAS, it is in the state's interest that access to postsecondary education for our children be maintained and that encouraging parents to save for their children's education promotes that public purpose; and

WHEREAS, government, at both the federal and state levels, needs to encourage savings versus borrowing and assist rather than hinder parents, grandparents, friends and businesses, as they seek to support the education of children, grandchildren and others in need of help to meet their higher education goals; and

WHEREAS, the state of Ohio administers CollegeAdvantage, a college savings plan, as a Section 529 Qualified Tuition Plan through duly enacted laws passed by the state's legislature; and


WHEREAS, many states, including Ohio, have offered state tax incentives as deductions and/or exemptions for their citizens as a recognition of the value of higher education.
